#### Update of Giving and Expenses from the Finance Team as of 6.30.2021

Giving	\$23,547	\$138,972	\$153,760	(\$14,788)

Net	\$300	(\$4,467)	(\$2,273)	(\$2,194)

Giving for June was \$2,018 under the budgeted amount for the month. We also had some unexpected expenses for air conditioning repair and repairs to the exterior of the children's ministry house that caused our expenses to be over budget by \$920. Thankfully, we were able to come out on the positive for the month of June with a gain of \$300. This gain helped reduce our YTD shortage from \$4,767 to \$4,467.
